

**Title of Item:** Optimization and storing hyperlinked functionality in MTI section when editing the template again.

**Description:** Users using the Mid-Term Inspection area of FLYdocs will be able to view any historical hyperlinks made to other Current Status tabs. Therefore, once the area in Mid Term Inspections is updated with a new hyperlink, the previous hyperlink will be saved in 'Historical Hyperlinks'. This ensures that any previous hyperlinked data is not lost as a result. When viewing the hyperlink, it will be read only access.

Module: Compile Files

Title of Item: Compilation output folder files should have the name same as Print

header of folder name.

**Description:** While initiating a compilation, FLYdocs can now have the file names based on the folder name. A new option has been added named 'Convert Filenames as Folder Name'. Once selected, the output of the compilation folder file names will be based on the folder name.

As an example, if the folder is named **74-08-09R3**, the file name format will be **74-08-09R3 -0001**, **74-08-09R3 -0002**, **74-08-09R3 -0003**.

This enhancement is applicable to Delivery Bible and Current Status compilations only.



Title of Item: Enhancement to Link aircraft registration from "Aircraft Centre" to

**Description:** The Asset history registration field will get updated automatically whenever editing from Contract Management. The registration added from Contract Management will not be editable but other fields will be editable.
